Plumbing leaks which could flood the unit or cause damage; electrical hazards; no heat/ac; clogged toilet, tub, sink if on a weekend and you have no second toilet/tub; and a completely clogged kitchen sink.

MAINTENANCE CHALLENGES

As most of you know, our region is dealing with staffing issues. Luminest shares in this struggle. We've continued to work short-staffed in our maintenance department. We've hired people who then left for higher wages, several even before they were fully trained; others had to be let go for various reasons. We continue to deal with this challenge. Often that leaves us with one trained person trying to do the job of two, or sometimes even three, people. We apologize for any inconveniences this may cause and appreciate those of you who show understanding and patience. We work according to the priorities we have established. Unfortunately, that means that sometimes we don't get to things like moving or trimming or less critical items as quickly as we would like (and as quickly as many of you were used to before Covid). We remain in the hiring and training process with the hope of finding long-term success soon. Please continue to call in your work orders so they are documented and remain in que. And feel free to call us if you haven't heard anything for 3 weeks or more. Our great team is doing their best and will continue to address things that are brought to our attention.

Our wonderful maintenance team will <u>always</u> knock on your door first when coming to do any work. If there is no response they will enter and very <u>loud-ly</u> announce their presence. They will also leave a notice of entry if you are not home.







All mailed payments should go to Luminest 82 W. Queen St. Chambersburg, PA 17201. You may drop off payments in an envelope with your name and address placed in the locked box in front of the office. Make checks out to Sunset—NOT Luminest.

All of Luminest properties are smoke free. You may smoke outside—25 ft. from buildings– but please <u>clean up you butts</u>. Do not leave butts in flower pots, etc.

Reminder—Please clean up after your pet. This is in your Lease and in your Handbook.
All pets should be registered with the office. Your pet should be on a leash & under your control when outside. Please make certain that your child can handle walking and cleaning up after their pets as well. Thank you.

Please make sure all trash is placed <u>in</u> the dumpster not next to or in front of but <u>in</u> the dumpster. <u>No large bulk items</u> (furniture, TV's, etc.) should be placed in dumpsters. You are responsible for disposal of larger items Do <u>NOT</u> put oil in the trash dumpsters! It leaks out and causes many environmental issues.

Do *NOT* drive on the grassy areas.

Maintenance will <u>not</u> move patio furniture or other items when mowing. Please keep area clear for mowing.

Grills- please make sure when using grills that they are 25ft from building (Fire Code) and put away when done. Do not leave anything on the grass.

Going forward, Maintenance will enter your unit to replace filters.
